**This is a show dedicated to pure and part bred Drafters, Ponies, and Longears/Exotics. The show is open to original finish plastic models, customized models, artist resins, and chinas of all scales.**

**Entries:** Entry fee is \$40.00 payable by check or money order made out to Marci Driscoll. No-fee PayPal entries will also be accepted - please email for instructions. Entries must be received by March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 (the Ides of March!)

**Tags:** This show will utilize the Region X Tag system. Please contact the keeper of the numbers, Jackie Arns at [drsteggy@drsteggy.com](mailto:drsteggy@drsteggy.com) for a number if you do not have one.

**Horse list:** Please bring in a list of the horses you have entered with their numbers the day of the show. You are encouraged to enter your horses on the Region X Tag Manager, located at [www.regionXnation.com](http://www.regionXnation.com).

**Space:** Participants will receive half of a banquet table with entry. You may bring a table cover to place over your section of the table. Storage space is limited; tubs and other materials will need to remain in your area. Showers may sell items from their tables.

**Awards:** Classes will be placed 1-6; halter classes will be double judged for breed and collectability (OF Plastic) or for breed and workmanship (CM and AR). This show is NAMSA approved and is a qualifying show for NAN 2010/2011. The show has also been approved as a Region X Regionals qualifying show for 2010/2011. NAN cards and RXR cards will be awarded to the first and second place entries in each class. Champions/Reserves for performance will be determined by points, and for halter will be determined by callbacks. Champions/Reserve Champions will receive custom rosettes.

**Order of classes:** Performance will begin first thing, with the china classes occurring concurrently with the performance division. Once performance classes have ended,

halter classes will begin in the order listed.

**Raffle:** A raffle will be held; donations of items is welcomed and appreciated. If you donate to the raffle, you will receive **two raffle tickets** in return!

**Lunch:** I am hoping to contact Subway to take orders as we normally do at K of C shows. You are also welcome to bring a lunch. A formal lunch break may or may not occur depending on time.

**Thank you to my awesome judges for volunteering your time and talents to make the show a success!**

**Important Points:**

- 2 entries per performance class per entrant, 3 horses per halter class per entrant. Models may show in both performance and halter divisions, **but classes will not be held for models engaged in one or the other.**
- There will be a **5 minute time limit** between performance classes; a timer will be used. You can and are encouraged to show your model in multiple performance classes, **but classes will not be held for tack changes**, etc. Please plan accordingly.
- For performance entries, a card describing your entry is **required**. For pleasure classes, a card is not required, but is recommended, especially for more obscure entries (i.e., draft horse pleasure, etc.).
- Documentation of breed information for halter classes is **recommended**, particularly for rare/unusual breeds, but should be kept to no more than an 8.5 X 11 inch sheet of paper.
- **Descriptive cards are required for collectability classes**; if your model does not have a card describing why it is collectible, it may not be judged.
- **Mixed breeds and cross breeds:** These models may go in the “other” class of

each halter division, or if they are a mix of two similar types (i.e., a Welsh/Connemara pony cross), they may go in the appropriate geographic class. Pick the class you feel your model is most competitive in – only one halter class per model. Feel free to ask the show hostess or judge if you need help.

The decision of the judges is final; if you have question about your entry or the placings, please ask the judge as soon as the class ends, when she/he can best assist you.
