# Color Crazy

Held in conjunction with the New England Model Dog Expo  
and the Random Mini Show

Date – March 31st 2012

**Concept:** To give everyone a chance to show off their older Breyer horses, those which may have terrific color, shading and detail, but generally get lost in the crowd at today's live shows. This show is intended for Breyers which are at least 20 years old, produced in America, and from an era when the equipment and handwork resulted in a great range of color, detail and appeal.

**Location:** Knights of Columbus Hall, 10 Meadow Road Spencer, MA

**Directions:** from Sturbridge, MA. Head east (away from Sturbridge center) on Route 20 (past the Cracker Barrel) to Route 49 North (left turn at light). Follow 49 to the junction of Route 9 (approx 7.4 miles). Bear/turn right onto Route 9 and travel approx ½ mile to lights with McDonalds on right corner. Turn left at light onto Meadow road. Stay to the left at the cemetery and the K of C will be on your right.

**Time:** Show hall opens at 8:00 a.m. Show starts promptly at 9:00 a.m.

**Eligibility:** This is an open fun show open to all showers, whether novice, intermediate or experienced. Due to the unique and fun format, it is not a NAN qualifier but it is a Region 10 qualifier.

**Entry Fee:** See Entry Form for fee scale. \$10.00 of your Color Crazy entry fee will be waived if you volunteer and are selected to judge the CC show.

**Benefit show:** A portion of the proceeds of this show (raffle, extra horse fees) will be donated to the Concord Coach Society, a non-profit organization in Hopkinton, NH, dedicated to education and the preservation of Concord Coaches and related historical documents. Visit [www.concordcoach.org](http://www.concordcoach.org) for more information on the Society.

**Raffle:** Raffle donations are cheerfully welcomed. Value at or above \$5.00 is appreciated. Models, discount coupons for show entries, paint jobs, tack, and the like, books, craft supplies, gift cards to hobby stores, etc are always met with enthusiasm. Tickets are \$1.00 each, six for \$5.00. Raffle proceeds allocated to the CC show will be donated to the benefit charity. The raffle will be drawn at the end of the lunch break, approximately 12:45. You must be present to win, or arrange for someone to collect your prize on your behalf.

**Food:** You are welcome to bring your own snacks, drinks (non-alcoholic) and lunch. There is a Subway and McDonalds nearby if you want to go out and get something. We will be taking orders for Subway delivery for those who are interested.

**Deadline:** Entry fee should be paid 7 days in advance (March 24th) to reserve your space. This show will be limited to approximately 40 showers on a first come, first served basis.

**Tags:** Please enter your horses into the Region 10 tag system database, which can be found at [www.annsmodels.com](http://www.annsmodels.com). It is free and easy to do. This will permit results to be generated in a timely manner. All horses should have a string tag on the leg with your Region 10 tag number on the front and your initials and horse's name on the back. Breed and gender assignment is optional for this show. Please turn in a list with your horse's name and number on the morning of the show and collect your CC show packet. If you don't have a list, you won't be able to show.

**Limit:** There is no limit to the number of horses you may bring, as long as they fit on your table. There is a maximum of 2 horses per class, per shower, in Divisions 1, 2 and 3. Additional horses in a class are \$0.50 each, which will be donated to the benefit organization. No cross entry of the same horse between Division 1 and Division 2. The same horse may enter in two classes in Division 3: one in Scale, one in Era. Classes will be split if warranted at the discretion of the judge. If there are sufficient show ring tables to do so, Division 1 and 2 will be judged at same time.

**Model Requirements:** Horses must be original finish and have been manufactured by Breyer Animal Creations or Reeves International prior to 1990 (the first year of Breyerfest). Any horse released for the first time (color and/or mold) in 1990 or after is not permitted to show. If your horse was produced prior to 1990 and is still in production in or after 1990, that horse is allowed to show. Any scale is permitted. Gloss, semi-gloss and matte horses will be shown together. Horses must be made out of cellulose acetate (Tenite) plastic. No other materials may be shown. Production dates to be determined by what is published in "Breyer Molds and Models" by Nancy A. Young (any edition). For the Era division, if horse was made for more than one decade, you may show in whichever decade you think your horse was most likely produced in. Equines only – no other species can be entered. No description cards are needed with any entry except for the collector's classes.

**Judging Criteria:** As this show's intent is to highlight the best of the best in color, there is no judging based on breed, gender, conformation or monetary value. Emphasis will be placed on Color (50%), Finish work (20%), Condition (20%) and Mold (10%). Finish work will include overspray, flashing, fogged masking, rough finish, etc. Condition will include rubs, breaks, split seams, yellowing, bent legs, etc. Some emphasis will be placed on the suitability and attractiveness of the color in relation to the mold it was painted on.

**Collector's Class:** The collector's class division will offer three classes: one for paper items, one for a model with provenance, and the third for 8 models judged on

collectability. Class 35, the vintage paper/ephemera class will be for paper and similar items from Breyer's history or your history collecting Breyers. For example, dealer and consumer catalogs, old sales lists, written correspondence with fellow collectors, receipts for purchases, etc. No computer downloads permitted. It will be judged on uniqueness, nostalgia, and diversity. Class 36 is for a single model in your collection, purchased in or before 1999, which you still have the receipt (letters or other documents), proving who you purchased it from and when (provenance), or other supporting materials. Class 37 is the standard 8 model collector's class and will be judged on age, color, condition, and rarity. All models in this class must be from before 1990 and be eligible to be shown in Division 1, 2 and/or 3. Description cards should accompany each of the models in class 34. These classes will be set up and judged during lunch, between 12:00 and 12:45 p.m.

**Champions:** To be determined by callbacks. First and second place horse in each class of Division 1, 2 and 3 will be called back and Top 5 horses will be selected, with Champion and Reserve included in the five. Overall Color Champ and Reserve to be awarded and will be selected from callbacks of Division 1-3 Champions and Reserves.

**Awards:** Commercial rosettes to Champion and Reserve, paper flats to class winners back to 10<sup>th</sup> place. Other awards may be provided.
